All competitors welcome. Dressage, eventing, team and FUN classes offered. We have classes to give competitors lots of opportunities to show off their horses! Please read showbill thoroughly.

Divisions: Youth/ Adult. Youth is under 18 as of Jan 1, Adult is 19 and up.

Ribbons: to 8th place

Classes: Classes split by divisions or combined if entries warrant. (Class abbreviation in bold for use on entry, specify day). All classes except costume class available both days.

Information / Fees: (Sorry, no refunds after closing date)

- **Class Fees:** Youth under 18 \$15 per class, Adult/Senior \$20 per class.
- **Number / office fee:** \$15 per entry for the weekend
- **Stalls** at \$50 a day & \$75 for weekend; Tack stalls \$45. **No shavings provided with stall fee - only wood shavings allowed. (Fairgrounds charges \$100 surcharge per stall if anything else used.)** Shavings available on grounds - \$7 a bag or bring from home.
- **Haul in** \$15 per day; **Camper / electrical hookup** \$35 per 24 hour period.
- **Late Entry Fee, if postmarked after closing date (9/24):** \$10. (Available if room)
- **Change/Add Class:** \$5 per class
- **Facilities:** Show will be held in outdoor sand rings. Sand pads and grassy open areas are available to warm up. Food available on grounds; Dogs must be on leashes; Standard dressage rules, especially regarding equipment. Test/class limit - five per day per horse.
- **Mandatory Helmet!** Dress code is relaxed. Boots or half-chaps, safe riding shoes with a heel, neat and clean shirt/jacket with a collar.
- **Ride times** will be available on the website (www.ohiodressagesociety.com). If rider needs ride times mailed (on-time entries only), please include a self-addressed & stamped envelope with the entry.
